He focused on <b>expressive</b> art.</p> <p>Goldsworthy makes natural sculptures and land art.</p>		<p>Computing</p> <p>An <b>algorithm</b> is a sequence of steps, instructions or rules that is used to perform a specific task. <b>Algorithms</b> can be followed by people or digital equipment. For <b>algorithms</b> to achieve the end goal, <b>instructions</b> have to be accurate and followed <b>sequentially</b>. Mistakes are called <b>bugs</b> and finding and fixing them is called <b>debugging</b>.</p>		<p>English</p> <p>A <b>non-chronological</b> report is a text that is not written in time order.</p> <p>A <b>narrative</b> is a piece of writing that focuses on telling a story. It's a story with a plot, characters, structure, setting and theme.</p>									
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
