INSPIRATIONAL ARTIST

As part of our whole school theme of Inspirational Artists, this half term we will looking at the artist from Year 6 which is Stephen Wiltshire. We hope to inspire the children to believe that they can achieve their dreams and learn lots of new art skills at the same time.

ANIMALS - Why don't snakes have legs?

We will be spending this half term taking a closer look at our topic of Animals and looking at answering our big question Why don't snakes have legs? by learning about similarities and differences of all animals, looking closely at reptiles and what they all have in common, look where different reptiles live and other facts that make them unique. We will continue to use a range of books for the children to use linked with this topic and we will be spending the last couple of weeks finding out more about dinosaurs. We will be using a selection of books in our Vipers sessions linked with our topic and we have attached our Knowledge Organiser which will give you more details about what we are planning on doing.
