The layers of the ocean are called:

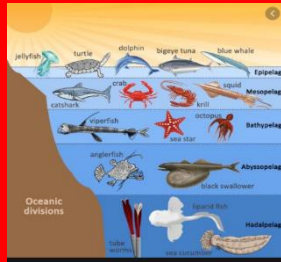
The Sunlight Zone (0- 200m)
