

Nursery – Knowledge Organiser – **Seasons** – What can you see in summer?

Understanding the World

- *Know that there are four seasons: autumn, winter, spring and summer.
- *Understand that each season has different types of weather.
- *Know that they can use all of their senses to begin to talk about their observations when exploring outside.
- *Understand the life cycle of a plant.

Physical Development

- *Be able to choose the most appropriate tools to complete a job e.g. a trowel to dig in soil.
- *Begin to negotiate around obstacles safely e.g. trees or branches when exploring outside.

Expressive Arts and Design

- *Create artwork using natural materials collected from exploring outside.

Maths

- *Begin to use positional language when talking about their observations or location.
- *Compare different lengths and heights of plants.
- *Extend repeating patterns using natural materials.

Vocabulary

- *Seasons – autumn, winter, spring, summer
- *Weather – sun/sunny, rain/rainy/raining, wind/windy, cloudy
- *Senses – see/eyes, hear/ears, smell/nose, feel
- *Positional – on, below, next to, above
- *Plants – seeds, soil, leaves, stem, roots

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- *Understand how to stay safe when exploring outside.

Fun Facts

- *Seasons change throughout the year because the earth moves.
- *Some trees stay green in all four seasons.
