INSPIRATIONAL ARTIST

As part of our whole school theme of **Inspirational Artists**, this half term we will looking at the artist from **Year 5** which is **Romero Britto**. We hope to **inspire** the children to **believe** that they can **achieve** their dreams and learn lots of new art skills at the same time.

SEASONS - What can you see in the summer?

We will be spending this half term taking a closer look at our topic of **Seasons** and looking at answering our big question. We will do this by learning about the **four seasons** by comparing their similarities and differences, exploring the outside by going on **nature walks** around the school, **Bulwell Hall Park** and a trip to the **Community Gardens**. By using all of our senses we hope that the children will begin to understand how the seasons and **weather** can change the world around us and we will be looking closely at how this effects **plants** by planting our own seeds. We will be using a selection of books in our **Vipers** sessions linked with our topic and we have attached our **Knowledge Organiser** which will give you more details about what we are planning on doing.

Our Traditional Tale for this half term is **The Little Red Hen** and our Nursery Rhyme is **Mary Mary Quite Contrary** and we will be regularly linking these into our daily provision including a staff performance of **The Little Red Hen** at the end of the term!
